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# - ITINERARY | DAY 1

## MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 29<sup>TH</sup> - WELCOME TO CATANIA

Meet with Philip and our local partner at **2.00 PM for a sparkling reception** in the courtyard of the Hotel and Spa Palazzo Sangiorgio in Catania. This hotel is an oasis of urban elegance in a quiet square in the heart of an ancient city.

### **GUIDED TOUR OF CATANIA'S HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS**

This afternoon we will be joined by a local specialist guide who will take us along the Via Etnea where ancient history meets modernity with stylish local stores before we are introduced to some of the many architectural examples of the many Sicilian occupations, marvel at the Piazza Duomo's Baroque buildings, the Basilica di Sant'Agata Cathedral itself, and hear about Catania's unique place among Italy's many and varied cityscapes. There will be a little free time this afternoon to further explore as you wish before returning to complete check in procedures if needed and relax before our evening together.

### **DEPART FOR DINNER**

This evening we will stroll for a few minutes through the ancient atmospheric streets of this ancient city, arriving at a top- rated restaurant in Catania where our welcome dinner awaits us. To conclude our first day wines will be chosen to discover varied and exciting tastes reflecting the different regions and terroirs of the sunniest island in Europe.

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## **ITINERARY | DAY 2**

## TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup> - SIRACUSA AND ORTIGIA

We try never to leave too early allowing for a relaxed breakfast.

### 9.30 am Depart hotel

### **VISIT AND TOUR OF ORTIGIA**

Our luxury bus will take us on a scenic one hour drive to the port of Siracusa (Syracuse) from where we will stretch our legs as we are guided to its historic centre, the island of Ortigia. The charming island with its stone buildings on the Ionian coast is known for the myth of Arethusa, its castle, Palazzos and the beautiful Duomo, situated on one of Italy's largest piazzas. We will see varied architectural styles and a Temple dedicated to Apollo. One could wander for hours through its picturesque squares and streets soaking up the atmosphere but our next port of call awaits us.

### VISIT AND LUNCH AT AZIENDA AGRICOLA PUPILLO

The remarkable family-owned Pupillo estate is located not far from the city, near the original Greek settlement. Caressed by the sea breezes and irrigated by the Val d'Anapo pure natural springs its limestone and volcanic soils produce a high quality and distinctive range of wines. These wines are very specific to the Siracusa denomination so offer a unique insight and which we will have the opportunity to taste and enjoy with lunch at the estate. www.cantinepupillo.it

### VISIT AND TASTING "in the footsteps of the Greeks" AT CANTINE GULINO

Before leaving the Syracuse area we travel a short distance South to the small town of Fanusa where Cantine Gulino is situated on a peninsula exposed to the marine influences of the Mediterranean. Founded in 1793 this is one of the oldest continuously producing wine estates in Sicily where the family have through several generations grown indigenous grape varieties such as the Royal Calavrisi, Noble Moscato di Siracusa and Albanello Siracusano, producing expressive wines for us to taste. On conclusion of this visit we will return to the hotel in Catania arriving around 6pm. www.cantinegulino.it

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## - ITINERARY | DAY 3

### WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup> - THE MAGIFICENCE OF TAORMINA

After yesterday's exertions there is ample time for a lazy breakfast before checking out.

10:15 am – Depart for Taormina.

### TOUR, TASTING AND LUNCH AT THE HISTORIC BARONE DI VILLAGRANDE ESTATE

Our bus takes us North toward the Etna DOC region at Milo and the Eastern slopes of Mount Etna. We arrive for a visit to an estate written into the lore of Etna wines for it was here in the eighteenth century that the Bishop of Catania gave the Asmundo family the task of taming the harsh landscape of Etna. It was here too that the first DOC Etna was written by Professor Carlo Nicolosi Asmundo. A private tour and lunch at the estate is accompanied by a selection of Barone di Villagrande wines before rejoining the bus for our visit to the picturesque and fashionable resort city of Taormina. www.villagrande.it

### **TOURING TAORMINA**

Taormina is perhaps the most dramatic and beautiful hilltop town on the coast of Sicily. It sits near the coast with stunning views of both the shimmering sea and Mount Etna. Taormina is most famous for its UNESCO listed ridge topping Greco-Roman Theatre which is still in use today and which has featured in many films. You will be taken on a private tour of the theatre before having a little free time to explore on your own. The views from the theatre and many other locations in this beautiful city offer countless photographic opportunities!

**Our bus will depart from Taormina at 5pm** for the 50-minute drive to our hotel near the village of Castiglione di Sicilia situated between the sea and the mountain.

### CHECK-IN AT IL PICCIOLO ETNA GOLF RESORT AND SPA

Our home for the next 2 nights is Il Picciolo Etna Golf Resort and Spa. This renovated Sicilian farmhouse, set between three national parks, offers classic elegance and contemporary comforts in an area of outstanding natural beauty, serenity, vineyards, and olives. www.ilpiccioloetnagolfresort.com/en-GB

This evening we depart for a very special wine tasting dinner at **Palmento Costanzo** just a few minutes away by bus. Here, at a recently restored ancient lava stone vineyard wine room, the Costanzo family have created a masterpiece of design and biodiversity. Our visit will explore the story of the "Muntagna" as we enjoy dinner accompanied by a wine selection including those from centennial vineyards actually situated in the Etna National Park. <u>www.palmentocostanzo.it</u>

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## - ITINERARY | DAY 4

## THURSDAY, OCTOBER 2<sup>ND</sup> - WINERIES OF THE NORTH ETNA WINE ROAD

After an introduction to the local culture and wines last evening our focus today is on the unique terroir and wineries of Etna's North Road.

### VISIT AND TASTING AT I VIGNERI

**I Vigneri,** the native Etna winegrowers are all men and women who originally hail from Mt. Etna. They have over the years built a comradeship and knowledge second to none with the goal to make what they call "Human Wines" based on totally sustainable principles. Leading the group is a remarkable man, Salvo Foti whose story, commitment to and participation in its wines reaches deep into many now famous wine companies of the region. We are privileged to have the chance to learn about his philosophy and indeed to taste wines from native varieties at the "Palmento" winery. www.ivigneri.it

### PRIVATE VISIT AND LUNCH AT PIETRADOLCE

Our bus now takes us to Solicchiata, a hamlet on the northern slopes of Mount Etna where Pietradolce is located. The ultra modern winery and re-modeled vineyard terraces make for a fascinating comparison with the ancient Palmentos but underneath the more modern exterior lies a very similar and deep attachment to the sense of place in this very special environment. Their range of eight wine styles are all clearly "Etna DOC." It is said that for other winemakers when not drinking their own production this the "go-to" winery! High praise indeed! With lunch we are very much looking forward to tasting some rare Pietradolce library wines. <u>www.pietradolce.com</u>
