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ARRIVAL | DAY 1

SUNDAY JUNE 7TH – ARRIVAL

Our journey begins at the legendary Hotel Imperial in Vienna, where we gather at 2:00 PM before setting off on a scenic drive of less than an hour into the heart of the Wachau Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

HOTEL DÜRNSTEIN CASTLE

The hotel offers both indoor and outdoor pools as well as a superb spa—everything you need for a relaxing and indulgent start to the trip.

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ITINERARY | DAY 2

MONDAY JUNE 8TH – THE GRAND ESTATES OF THE WACHAU

10:00 AM – DEPART HOTEL

This morning we remain in the Wachau Valley, where the famed vineyard “Lagen” (crus) are clustered closely together. Despite their proximity, you will be amazed at how distinctive each vineyard tastes—even when side by side.

DOMAIN WACHAU – TOUR AND TASTING

Our day starts at Domaine Wachau, the celebrated cooperative that showcases the diversity of the region’s terroirs. Here, we will enjoy a masterclass led by Roman Horvath MW, who directs the estate. You will taste an impressive spectrum of wines, including single-vineyard “Lagen,” several ranked among the Top 50 vineyards of the world, surpassing even some of Bordeaux’s most famous names. <https://www.domaene-wachau.at/en/>

WACHAUERSTUBE – LUNCH

Next, we step off the tourist path and into one of the Wachau’s most authentic gems. Wachauerstube is a traditional Austrian “Stubn”—literally translating to “living room.” Here, it feels as though you are dining in someone’s home. We will enjoy hearty Austrian specialties such as Schweinsbraten (slow-roasted pork) and classic dumplings, all paired with the region’s finest wines.

KNOLL – PRIVATE TASTING

In the afternoon, we visit the iconic Knoll estate. This revered winery rarely opens its doors to visitors, but for our group, Emmerich Knoll himself will host an exclusive tasting. The estate is renowned for its elegance, precision, and rare varieties such as Traminer and Gelber Muskateller. So sought-after are Knoll’s wines that they sell out before release, making them a true cult favorite.

DOMAIN ALZINGER – PRIVATE TASTING

Our day concludes at the Alzinger estate, nestled in the heart of the Wachau valley, renowned for its remarkably steep crus. Each wine embodies an unparalleled precision in the glass. You will have the opportunity to meet the esteemed Alzinger family, whose dedication to crafting internationally-acclaimed wines is evident in their meticulous hands-on vineyard practices. <https://alzinger.at/en/>

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ITINERARY | DAY 3

TUESDAY JUNE 9TH – HIDDEN GEMS – KREMSTAL & WAGRAM

10.00 AM – DEPART HOTEL

After a delicious breakfast, we leave the Wachau and head north on a short drive of only 20 minutes to the Kremstal and Wagram. These two regions boast centuries of winemaking tradition and produce some of Austria's most prized wines.

JURTSCHITSCH – TOUR AND TASTING

Our morning begins with a visit to the Jurtschitsch estate, a family-owned and operated winery dedicated to producing terroir-driven wines of elegance and purity. All wines are certified organic, crafted with minimal intervention to let the vineyards speak for themselves. We will enjoy a private tour and tasting with Alwin Jurtschitsch, one of Austria's most respected winemakers.

NIKOLAIHOF – TOUR, TASTING AND LUNCH

Next, we travel back in time at Nikolaihof, Austria's oldest winery with over 2,000 years of history. The estate is also among these, who have received a perfect 100-point score from Robert Parker. During our tour, we will see the world's oldest working grape press, followed by a tasting led by the owner. We then enjoy a seasonal lunch prepared from recipes created by Mrs. Saahs, the matriarch of the estate. Her cooking focuses on regional produce, herbs, and traditional Austrian flavors.

WEDNESDAY JUNE 10TH – A SPARKLING DAY ON THE RIVER

10:00 AM – Depart and check out of hotel

BRÜNDLMAYER – TOUR AND TASTING

Following our tranquil river voyage, we visit the celebrated Weingut Bründlmayer. World-renowned for both still wines and sparkling Austrian Sekt, Bründlmayer has triumphed over Champagne in international blind tastings. Our tour includes a behind-the-scenes look at the winery, followed by a sparkling tasting hosted by Andreas Wickhoff MW, one of Austria's most respected Masters of Wine. His expertise will guide us through an unforgettable lineup of Bründlmayer wines.

After the tasting, we enjoy a traditional Austrian Jause—a casual yet indulgent lunch of regional meats, cheeses, and specialties.

HOTEL IMPERIAL VIENNA & HORSE CARRIAGE RIDE

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ITINERARY | DAY 5

THURSDAY JUNE 11TH –ROYAL – BURGENLAND

09:30 AM – DEPART

This morning we set off south towards Burgenland, home to the magnificent Esterházy Palace and the famed Lake Neusiedl. Our scenic one hour drive offers beautiful views of the rolling countryside as we make our way to the wine heartland of the region.

ESTERHAZY PALACE & WINERY – WINE MUSEUM, TOUR, TASTING AND LUNCH

Our day begins at the extraordinary Esterházy Palace, once the summer residence of Austrian royalty, including the legendary Empress Sisi. Dating back to the 14th century, the palace today houses a remarkable wine museum.

After an exclusive guided tour of the castle and museum, we continue with a short transfer to the palace's own winery. Here, we enjoy a tasting with a lineup that includes distinguished reds such as Blaufränkisch, a variety unique to Austria, as well as elegant Pinot Noirs. The wines will be perfectly paired with artisanal sausages from their own production, local cheeses, and fresh garden vegetables.

PALAIIS COBURG – SILVIO NICKOL – DINNER AND CELLAR TOUR

This evening, just a five-minute walk from the hotel, we enjoy the grand finale of our Austrian adventure at Palais Coburg.

Our evening begins with a private tour of their legendary wine cellar, holding over 60,000 bottles. Highlights include every vintage of Château d'Yquem since 1893 and one of the world's oldest drinkable wine from 1727. Following this once-in-a-lifetime experience, we dine at the two-Michelin-starred Silvio Nickol restaurant. FRIDAY JUNE 12TH – VIENNA

SCHÖNBRUNN PALACE – BAKING DEMONSTRATION AND TASTING

MAYER AM PFARRPLATZ – TASTING AND LUNCH

Our final lunch together takes us to Mayer am Pfarrplatz, one of only a handful of wineries located within Vienna itself. The city is internationally recognized for its unique Gemischter Satz (“Field Blend”), a traditional method where multiple grape varieties are fermented together. We’ll enjoy a guided tasting of Vienna’s finest wines, followed by a family-style lunch—a fitting way to end the tour, as by now you will surely feel like part of an Austrian family. Adding to the charm, our lunch venue is housed in the former residence of Ludwig van Beethoven, who composed some of his greatest works here. <https://www.pfarrplatz.at/en/>

Schlumberger – TOUR AND TASTING
